## 2022 FLOOD DISASTER AND PLANS MADE BY THE PRESIDENTIAL COMMITTEE ON FLOOD RELIEF AND REHABILITATION (PCFRR) IN PARTNERSHIP WITH THE NATIONAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (NEMA) TO PROVIDE RELIEF MATERIALS (FOOD AND NON- FOOD) TO THE VICTIMS OF THE FLOOD ACROSS THE NATION

Following the receipt of a distress call from the National Emergency Management Agency (NEMA) seeking the Committee's assistance of food and non-food items in order to mitigate the impacts of the 2022 floods in Nigeria; the Co-Chairmen of the Presidential Committee on Flood Relief and Rehabilitation (PCFRR) summoned an emergency meeting on **Thursday, 13<sup>th</sup> October, 2022**, at the Committee's Secretariat, **No. 38, Jimmy Carter Street, Asokoro, Abuja**.

2. The meeting was well attended by the members of the Committee and critical stakeholders/partners. The Committee used the avenue of the meeting to brief those in attendance about the reports received from NEMA and some States across the nation, on the negative consequences of the 2022 floods on Nigerians. Thereafter, the DG/NEMA made an elaborate presentation on the disaster. After a very extensive deliberation, the meeting approved that the Committee should take urgent steps to provide some Relief materials; (food and non-food) through NEMA, for distribution to the victims of the flood disasters in all the States affected as a palliative measure. For this purpose, the meeting approved a total sum of **N1,500,000,000.00 (One Billion, Five Hundred Million Naira)** only for the procurement and supply of the said food and non-food Relief Materials to NEMA warehouses across the six geo-political zones in Nigeria. It was further approved that NEMA, should furnish the Committee with the locations and addresses of their Zonal Warehouses in the six (6) geo-political zones of Nigeria for the delivery of the Relief Materials.

3. Currently, the procurement and delivery of the items are on-going and the actual distribution will be determined by NEMA in due course.

4. On its part, NEMA has written to express its profound appreciation to the Committee, for responding positively to its clarion call for support in addressing the flood emergencies in Nigeria. Similarly, NEMA has furnished the

Committee with the addresses/locations of its warehouses in each of the six (6) geo-political zones of the country, as well as the contact person for each zone.

5. In all, the Committee will deliver to NEMA the following food and non-food items:

- (i) **Rice (50kg):** 500 bags per geo-political zone and **3,000 bags** in all the 6 zones;
- (ii) **Beans (100kg):** 200 bags per geo-political zone and **1,200 bags** in all the 6 zones;
- (iii) **Millet (100kg):** 200 bags per geo-political zone and **1,200 bags** in all the 6 zones;
- (iv) **Maize (100kg):** 200 bags per geo-political zone and **1,200 bags** in all the 6 zones;
- (v) **Guinea Corn (100kg):** 200 bags per geo-political zone and **1,200 bags** in all the 6 zones;
- (vi) **Garri (100kg):** 200 bags per geo-political zone and **1,200 bags** in all the 6 zones;
- (vii) **Noodles:** 500 cartons per geo-political zone and **3,000 cartons** in all the 6 zones;
- (viii) **Spaghetti:** 500 cartons per geo-political zone and **3,000 cartons** in all the 6 zones;
- (ix) **Macaroni 500:** cartons per geo-political zone and **3,000 cartons** in all the 6 zones;
- (x) **Dan Q Seasoning:** 100 cartons per geo-political zone and **600 cartons** in all the 6 zones;
- (xi) **Salt (20kg):** 200 bags per geo-political zone and **1,200 bags** in all the 6 zones;
- (xii) **Sugar (10kg):** 500 bundles per geo-political zone and **3,000 bundles** in all the 6 zones;

- (xiii) **Tomatoes Paste:** 300 cartons per geo-political zone and **1,800 cartons** in all the 6 zones;
- (xiv) **Vegetable Oil (25 litre):** 200 kegs per geo-political zone and **1,200 kegs** in all the 6 zones;
- (xv) **Palm Oil (25 litre):** 200 kegs per geo-political zone and **1,200 kegs** in all the 6 zones;
- (xvi) **Mattresses (2 x 6):** 600 units per geo-political zone and **3,600 units** in all the 6 zones;
- (xvii) **Guinea Brocade (shadda) (5 yards):** 6,000 no. per geo-political zone and **36,000 no.** in all the 6 zones;
- (xviii) **Wax Print (6 yards):** 6,000 no. per geo-political zone and **36,000 no.** in all the 6 zones;
- (xix) **Blankets (standard):** 6,000 pcs. per geo-political zone and **36,000 pcs.** in all the 6 zones;
- (xx) **Towels:** 1,200 pcs. per geo-political zone and **7,200 pcs.** in all the 6 zones;
- (xxi) **Mosquito Nets:** 6,000 pcs. per geo-political zone and **36,000 pcs.** in all the 6 zones;
- (xxii) **Nylon Mats:** 6,000 pcs. per geo-political zone and **36,000 pcs.** in all the 6 zones;
- (xxiii) **Bath Soap:** 200 cartons per geo-political zone and **1,200 cartons** in all the 6 zones;
- (xxiv) **Detergent:** 150 cartons per geo-political zone and **900 cartons** in all the 6 zones;
- (xxv) **Plastic Cups:** 300 dozens per geo-political zone and **1,800 dozens** in all the 6 zones;
- (xxvi) **Plastic spoons:** 300 dozens per geo-political zone and **1,800 dozens** in all the 6 zones;
- (xxvii) **Plastic Plates:** 300 dozens per geo-political zone and **1,800 dozens** in all the 6 zones;

- (xxviii) **Plastic buckets/covers:** 100 dozens per geo-political zone and **600 dozens** in all the 6 zones;
- (xxix) **Roofing Sheets:** 200 bundles per geo-political zone and **1,200 bundles** in all the 6 zones;
- (xxx) **Cement:** 5,000 bags per geo-political zone and **30,000 bags** in all the 6 zones;
